In the changing rooms please keep numbers as low as you can. (8 maximum at any one time) - Players and official's ground entrance will be closed after 2pm (Saturday) and 18.45 (midweek), therefore no one can access the changing rooms area. Please arrive in time and inform your players to not make any unnecessary trips out of the changing room area including the clubhouse to avoid contact with other people.

In the dugout please keep numbers as low as possible & observe social distancing. Substitutes should wear masks if they wish to sit together in the dugout.

Showers are available, but occupancy must be only two people at any one time. Please confirm Yes or No as to whether your players and officials will be visiting the club house after the game. Track and trace will also be in place within the clubhouse. We will reserve an area / tables for them.

In the event of a Covid incident being reported post match, the manager or secretary must contact or supply a list of phone number and names of people who were part of the squad / management team for that fixture to AFC Hayes for track and trace purposes.

All persons entering the ground must comply with the following **Ground Regulations**.

Failure to do so may result in being asked to leave the ground and a ban from attending any future events in the ground.

Admission and the right to remain within the ground is on condition that all persons refrain from the following acts:

- 1. Failure to comply with any legal directions given by a club official, steward or police officer.
- 2. Entering the field of play before, during or after the game.
- 3. Using obscene or abusive language.
- 4. Making racial or other forms of abuse.

- 6. Climbing on any building, wall, fence or floodlights.

- 9. The throwing of any missile, object or projectile.

LEAGUE PREVIEW

So we have a second chance to finish in the top four of the Cherry Red Records Combined Counties League Division One.

This will earn us promotion to what will be a restructured Football Pyramid from next season.

It should have been happening now but Covid-19 put paid to that.

In short, the 2019-20 was made null-and-void but we have printed on page 13 what became the final table when the season was halted in mid-March.

The obvious point to make was that Jersey Bulls had effectively taken the title although not mathematically.

Should they have been allowed to get promoted? Everyone will have their views on this one.

But league rules should now be adjusted if this type of scenario should happen again.

Hopefully we can avoid alogarithms but surely a simple points per game would suffice provided at least half of the season is played.

Maybe some adjustments are necessary because of the irregular number of games that are played at any point of the season particularly during the winter months.

When the 2019-20 campaign came to a halt, FC Deportivo Galicia had played 30 but AFC Hayes had played only 22.

Maybe it should be based on the lowest number of games played - in this instance 22.

Then calculate how many points each team had after 22 matches. However they could receive a bonus points per game if their form improved in their remaining matches. However, no penalty if their form declined.

This is something the league hierarchy need to look at as it is possible there could be more disruption before the Covid-19 is under control.

As it is, it is probably to AFC Hayes' advantage that we are having a re-run of the 2019-20 league season but certainly not for Jersey Bulls. They should have been allowed to be promoted.

There is uncertainty about Jersey Bulls' situation. Will clubs be able to travel to their ground and what are their arrangements for away fixtures?

On the field a key question is will any side be able to take a point off Jersey Bulls or even beat them. The Brook gave them a run for their money at Farm Park so could AFC Hayes be the team to celebrate a memorable result against The Bulls?

There may be a few teams that will have better seasons including AFC Hayes so the final four could be a little different than the way the last campaign finished in mid-March.

The top four could be Jersey Bulls, AFC Hayes, Epsom & Ewell and Godalming Town and the bottom four: Chessington & Hook, Ash United, Cove and Bagshot.

FOCUS ON EPSOM & EWELL

We were founded in March 1918 as Epsom Juniors Cricket Club and played throughout the summer.

In the autumn, Epsom Juniors FC came into being and played a handful of games from what is now known as Alexandra Recreation Ground. Competitive football followed as we entered the Surrey Junior League in 1919, and became founder members of the Sutton & District League in 1920.

In 2016-17 Epsom & Ewell started the season with an incredible 9-2 win at newly promoted Bedfont & despite trailing 2-0 at half time and went on to repeat our fourth place finish in the League. In addition, we reached the League Cup final but were defeated 4-1 by Westfield at Windsor.

However, in the summer of 2017, we suffered a large player exodus with a substantial number joining local rivals Sutton Common Rovers. Glyn was unable to replace them with enough players of real quality and three quarters of the season was spent at the foot of the table. His resignation in January 2018 led to the club promoting our coach Neil Grant into the manager's role and although he managed to get us off the foot of the

table, relegation was always likely and was confirmed in mid-April; not a great way to celebrate our Centenary!

The attempts at bouncing straight back did not start particularly well and Grant departed in October. He was replaced by Simon Funnell, who stepped up from his assistant role and oversaw a good run of results which took us as high as eighth with the consolation of reaching the Division One League Cup Final at Meadowbank.

Unfortunately the 2019-20 campaign started poorly and Funnell resigned at Christmas. His assistant Sam Morgan was appointed to the role and with his new Assistant Tim Moffatt they oversaw an undefeated league run that took us up to the abandonment of the season.

The 2020-21 season commences with another ground move, this time to Leatherhead's Fetcham Grove ground after several years at Chipstead. The target of promotion back into the top flight of the Combined Counties League remains the same as the previous year.

Meanwhile, the search continues for a new ground back in the Borough...
