

There was a healthy crowd of 107 so our two most recent home fixtures have had an attendance of over 100; the days of 20 or 30 at Chipstead seem a distant memory.

As for the team, there was only one change from the previous week with Gavin Quintyne coming in for the suspended Nick Wilson.

We had the better of the opening exchanges and with a bit more composure and luck might have taken the lead. There were chances early on for Athan Smith-Joseph, Josh Owen and Jamie Byatt - but all to no avail. As for our visitors, they were left with two long-range headers which ended tamely in our keepers' arms - Half-time 0-0.

The second half was very similar to the first with us pressing for the opening goal, the opposition keeper never looked comfortable under any cross. The game changed with 2 minutes to go when the referee awarded a penalty to Shoreham for a trip inside the penalty box, the resultant kick was brilliantly saved by Kane Charles however, he was not able to hold onto the ball and the penalty taker was able to find the net, so 1-0 to Shoreham. It looked like this was going to be a damaging defeat at home to one of our promotion rivals and then in the 96th minute (a bit like the lengthy injury time in the current World Cup), we were able to equalise through Athan Smith-Joseph.

In summary, this a good point which was a fair result, we remain top of the league.

East Preston FC was initially formed in 1947, but unfortunately, within ten years the club had folded. However, it was reformed, as the present club in 1966 when it was elected to the Worthing League.

East Preston then moved on to the West Sussex League for the start of the 1968/69 season before becoming founder member of the newly formed Sussex County League Division Three in 1983/84, has won several honours in the seasons leading up to that.

The club won Division Three at the first attempt but was unable to take their place in senior football as the ground and facilities were not up to the required standard.

The club remained in Division Three until 1990/91 when they gained promotion again, this time as runners-up to Ifield. However, this lasted just one season before being relegated back the following year. After a couple of near misses, they finally achieved promotion again at the end of the 1994/95 season. In that promotion season, they achieved a memorable treble, also winning the Division 3 Cup and the Sussex Intermediate Cup.

In 1997/98 promotion to Division One was achieved for the first time in the club's history. The club acquitted itself well for two seasons, finishing fourth in 1999/00 before a season of the crisis saw them relegated in 2000/01. Recovery, however, was swift and East Preston was immediately promoted back to the top flight. Following a season of consolidation, 2003/04 saw East Preston once again a leading force in the top division, finishing third behind Chichester City United, and just missing out on the runners-up spot-on goal difference to Rye & Iden United.

2004/05 saw somewhat mixed fortunes, with the club managing only a mid-table finish. To some extent progress was hampered by disquiet behind the scenes, culminating in December with the failure of the 1st team squad to fulfil a fixture at Eastbourne Town and the ultimate resignation of manager Vic Short. To some extent, this took the gloss off an excellent run in the FA Cup that saw the club eventually bow out at home to Billericay Town at the 3rd Qualifying Round stage (see photographs), whilst there was also no disgrace in losing at eventual winners Didcot Town in the 2nd Round of the FA Vase.

Given the previous season's upheavals and the loss of many of the playing squad, East Preston was widely tipped to struggle in 2005/06 and eventually finished in 16th place. The following season saw an improvement as the club finished in a comfortable mid-table position that may serve as a springboard to a further revival.

After 2 good seasons under Chris White, he departed to Horsham YMCA. The club was eventually relegated to Division 2 under former reserve team manager Trevor Waller in 2009 where they failed to set the world alight, finishing mid-table 2 seasons running.

For the start of the 2011/12 season, Dominic Di Paola was appointed manager, bringing with him his backroom staff of Ian Browne, Jan Miller and Adam Westwood from Worthing United where they had gained promotion from Division 2 the previous season.

The 2011/12 season proved to be a very successful one as the club ran away with the Division 2 title, securing promotion before any other senior side in the country and also claiming the league and cup double, beating local rivals Littlehampton 5-1 in the Division 2 cup final.

In the 2012/13 season, East Preston finished 3rd in Div 1 and 2013/14 won the Div 1 title by 17 pts but were denied entrance into the Rymans League due to not meeting the ground grading requirements.

Seven on the hounce

As the title depicts this was our 7th win on the trot when we beat East Preston at their ground on Saturday 1st October. It was a compelling win and the scoreline did not reflect our dominance over the 90 minutes.

We had to make a very late change to the team when 'Sonic' Akoto pulled up in the warm-up with a slight hamstring strain, but we had a ready-made replacement on the bench in Gideon Acheampong. We have lost Richard Pingling, Adam Grant and Louis Chin who have moved onto pastures new, so the squad was slightly changed from winning at Godalming Town. Josh Owen made a start for us and Josh Alder was back after joining Oakwood for a short while and was on the subs bench; it was also good to see Steve Springett on the bench after 5 weeks out with a nasty hand injury.

As previously mentioned, it was one-way traffic from the kickoff and what was most surprising was that it took until the 35th minute for us to take the lead from a superb low drive by Ryan Smith from just outside the box. Our keeper had been very much a spectator throughout the first half and the only surprise was that we did not increase our lead. Half time 1-0.

It was only after 9 minutes into the second half before we increased our lead and began to put the game 'to bed' after a great through ball, Athan Smith-Joseph rounded the keeper and passed the ball into the empty net. We made it 3-0 in the 72nd minute as our substitute Jaevon Dyer, finished after a great pass by Josh Owen. In the 3rd minute of injury time we conceded a sloppy goal to make the final score 3-1 and another win 'on the road'.


