

There was a healthy crowd of 107 so our two most recent home fixtures have had an attendance of over 100; the days of 20 or 30 at Chipstead seem a distant memory.

As for the team, there was only one change from the previous week with Gavin Quintyne coming in for the suspended Nick Wilson.

We had the better of the opening exchanges and with a bit more composure and luck might have taken the lead. There were chances early on for Athan Smith-Joseph, Josh Owen and Jamie Byatt - but all to no avail. As for our visitors, they were left with two long-range headers which ended tamely in our keepers' arms - Half-time 0-0.

The second half was very similar to the first with us pressing for the opening goal, the opposition keeper never looked comfortable under any cross. The game changed with 2 minutes to go when the referee awarded a penalty to Shoreham for a trip inside the penalty box, the resultant kick was brilliantly saved by Kane Charles however, he was not able to hold onto the ball and the penalty taker was able to find the net, so 1-0 to Shoreham. It looked like this was going to be a damaging defeat at home to one of our promotion rivals and then in the 96th minute (a bit like the lengthy injury time in the current World Cup), we were able to equalise through Athan Smith-Joseph.

Welcome

FC Deportivo Galicia

Founded: 1968

Home Ground: Bedfont Recreation Ground, Bedfont

The founding and birth of FC Deportivo Galicia in London came about due to a shared understanding and sentiment by a group of Galician migrants who came to the United Kingdom in the 60s.

The political and economic situation surrounding Spain at the time was so difficult that families found themselves choosing to settle in an unknown country in the hope of a better and more prosperous future. The most trying thing for these families was the constant nostalgic battle on a day-to-day basis remembering and missing the land that gave them life, the territory they belonged to.

During the 60s it was west London that saw the majority of Galician migrants settle down and it was in 1968 that a small group of those migrants saw an opportunity, through football, to help each other and somehow share the longing they felt for Spain.

The club was initially formed under the name 'Centro Gallego de Londres' however a few years later it joined forces with another Spanish team called 'Deportivo' (a club that was formed in honour and memory of FC Deportivo in foreign country) and so came the creation of 'FC Deportivo Galicia de Londres'. The name, perceptibly capturing not only the essence of the 'Real Club Deportivo La Coruna' but also the spirit and heart of the whole of Galicia.

Until 1995 the team played in the 'Harlseden Sunday League' and progressed continually and consistently which saw them slowly catapulted into the first division for the 1991-1992 season.

This would become the most successful and fruitful era in the club's history so much so that in the 1993-94 season the team won every competition it took part in. The club did not only win the treble, first division, Premier Cup and Challenge Cup but they also accomplished the Roundwood indoor football tournament.

The second team formed in the 1991-92 season was also successful during this period winning trophies such as the Dwyer Cup.

The club decided to take the next logical step in progression and move up a level as a result of achieving all it could within its reach.



For the 1995-96 season the team began playing in the Middlesex County league on Saturdays.

In this first year, the first team won the second-division league and was consequently awarded Intermediate Status by the London FA.

The club continued to prosper until reaching the first division in the 1997-98 season. It is at this point when for the first time there are signs of instability in the club as there is a clear high turnover in coaches without managing to fulfil the club's potential and never achieving the level expected of them.

As the 2006-07 season drew to an end the club found itself having to make the tough decision of dissolving the club. The toughest moment in our history by far.

Two long-standing players, Leo Decabo and Jose M Andon refused to give up on the club that had given so much purpose, life and soul to individuals throughout the years making a mark on the history of Calicians in London and so decided to take charge with the sole purpose of reviving the club and ensuring London was not left without a Spanish club.

The club is recognized, not only in Spain but in Europe, for deservedly being dubbed as one of the best Spanish amateur teams in a foreign country. The club has shown strength and belief whilst proving why others should fear them by claiming international trophies in Germany, France and Belgium.

Thursday 25th April 2013 proved to be a very significant day for the club as it received one of the most prestigious and vital accreditation on behalf of the English Football Federation, the honour of being recognized as a 'FA Charter Standard Club'. This award and recognition are the results of sheer hard work, determination consistency and teamwork on behalf of all key parts and members that form part of FC Deportivo Galicia de Londres, players, management, admin and supporters.

Most players that are now part of the team are in fact sons and grandsons of those who were once part of the original team.

As the team of Centro Gallego de Londres, Centro supports and provides some sponsorship to the team.

Unfortunately, this contribution is not near enough to what a team in this position and of this standard needs to keep developing.

This is why we are the only team within our category in which the players and coaches finance the club themselves with monthly payments and season inductions.

From the archive

Seven on the hounce

As the title depicts this was our 7th win on the trot when we beat East Preston at their ground on Saturday 1st October. It was a compelling win and the scoreline did not reflect our dominance over the 90 minutes.

We had to make a very late change to the team when 'Sonic' Akoto pulled up in the warm-up with a slight hamstring strain, but we had a ready-made replacement on the bench in Gideon Acheampong. We have lost Richard Pingling, Adam Grant and Louis Chin who have moved onto pastures new, so the squad was slightly changed from winning at Godalming Town. Josh Owen made a start for us and Josh Alder was back after joining Oakwood for a short while and was on the subs bench; it was also good to see Steve Springett on the bench after 5 weeks out with a nasty hand injury.

As previously mentioned, it was one-way traffic from the kickoff and what was most surprising was that it took until the 35th minute for us to take the lead from a superb low drive by Ryan Smith from just outside the box. Our keeper had been very much a spectator throughout the first half and the only surprise was that we did not increase our lead. Half time 1-0.

It was only after 9 minutes into the second half before we increased our lead and began to put the game 'to bed' after a great through ball, Athan Smith-Joseph rounded the keeper and passed the ball into the empty net. We made it 3-0 in the 72nd minute as our substitute Jaevon Dyer, finished after a great pass by Josh Owen. In the 3rd minute of injury time we conceded a sloppy goal to make the final score 3-1 and another win 'on the road'.


