

Arundel (A) – 25th March '23

Well, not the result that was required. A very poor and disjointed display resulted in a 5-1 defeat: our heaviest one of the season.

The pitch was deemed fit after a 10 am inspection by the referee for the match. There were changes from the side that beat Montpelier Villa two weeks ago with Ollie Thompson returning to the centre of defence and Kevin Gomez coming back into the left-back berth. The absent Athan Smith-Joseph was replaced on the left wing by Louis Perch.

We fell behind after Arundel's first attack after a mix-up at the back and no sooner were we 1-0 down than we found ourselves further behind after a swirling corner kick found its way into our net. During periods of the first half, we had caused challenges for the Arundel back line but all to no avail. We then found ourselves further behind when Arundel scored their 3rd goal. HT 3-0.

We made two changes at halftime with Rory Edwards coming into midfield and adding some much-needed energy and Steve Springett replacing Kevin Gomez who felt ill at halftime.

In the 50th minute, we got a goal back from who else but Jamie Byatt who scored from approximately 10 yards out. We were then in the ascendency and you could see our opponents visibly unsettled; we had at least two further chances to claw an additional goal back. Then with Arundel's first actual attack of the second half, they scored their 4th goal, and their 5th goal followed shortly afterwards. This was in the end the final result.

We need to consign this match to history very quickly as we face Mile Oak twice in 3 days in the coming week, with our first encounter at their place on Wednesday evening and then we host them at Fetcham next Saturday.

Mile Oak FC was formed in 1960 and started in Division eight of the Brighton, Hove & District Football League and won the division at the first attempt, and was promoted to Division six.

Further promotion followed in the 1963-64 season when the club finished as runners-up in Division six and the club was promoted again the following season. The club's first attempt at Division four saw them finish as champions, however four seasons later and the club was back in Division five.

A season later they were back in Division four and the 1971-72 campaign saw them finish as runners-up and promotion Division two. The club had instant success in Division two finishing as champions, a feat they repeated the next season in Division one. The 1980-81 season saw the club become winners of the Brighton League.

In 1986 decided to leave the Brighton, Hove & District Football League to become a senior club in the Sussex County League, and an application was made to join the Southern Counties Combination League, which was a feeder into the Sussex 'pyramid'.

After just one season, the club won promotion to Division Three of the County League as champions. After five seasons, promotion was gained to Division Two in 1991-92, as runners-up to Hassocks, and then to Division One as champions in 1994-95. They stayed in this division for three seasons and were relegated back to Division two in 1997-98.

In 2005-06 they won some silverware after defeating Sidlesham 1-0 in the Final of the Division Two Challenge Cup. In the 2008-09 season, the club again gained promotion to Division one but only survived one season back in the top flight of the Sussex league. In the 2014/15 season, the Sussex league was renamed the Southern counties league with divisions 1, 2 and 3 being renamed premier, division 1 and division 2 respectively.

Our first fixture against Mile Oak came back in September 2021. We ran out 4-0 winners at home in the 2nd qualifying round of the FA Vase. The match report is available on the next page.

From the Archive

Mile Oak (H) – Sat 25th September '21

Our newly appointed manager Darren Ansfold took charge for the first time against Mile Oak and the team responded well with a great 4-0 win to keep the unbeaten run going to 6 games (5 wins and one draw and another clean sheet). Unfortunately, due to the apparent petrol shortage, the attendance was well down on the corresponding Vase fixture of last season. This shortage impacted our opponents a lot by them only being able to field 11 players with their manager named as their only substitute; this would have an effect later in the second half as they began to tire and the game became more open.

The team remained unchanged from the match against Roffey and started very well. However, in the 2nd minute, there was a nasty accidental clash between Matt Bishop, our goalkeeper and the Mile Oak no 9 (Harry Furnell) which resulted in Bishop having to have a few minutes of treatment before he was able to carry on. Only a few minutes later in the 7th minute, we took the lead after a looping leftwing cross from Luke Miller was met by the in-form Jamie Byatt to power a header into the left-hand corner of the goal. Shortly after the goal Mile Oak had their best chance of the match when a shot cannoned off our crossbar but rolled to safety. We had to wait until the 23rd minute of the match for the first corner which was awarded to Epsom, from the resultant kick Adam Grant headed towards the goal but the Mile Oak keeper (Aaron Stenning) made a smart save. However, in the 27th minute, we increased our lead with a carbon copy effort which Adam Grant met with some force to find the same corner of the net that Byatt did for the first goal. The remainder of the half was played out very comfortably by ourselves, so we led 2-0 at halftime.

The second half started in the same vein with us being on top and we forced two early corners in the 55th minute which came to nothing. Then in the 58th minute, Tarig Straker, our left-back beat his man down the wing and hit a perfect outside-ofthe-foot pass to Jamie Byatt who had no trouble finishing from just outside the sixyard box to make it three-nil. This prompted a couple of substitutions as we began to look ahead to an important home league game on Tuesday evening against Oakwood. Straker came off and was replaced by Haywood-Roye who slipped into the right-back position with Louis Chin moving over to left-back, this was followed shortly afterwards by Steve Springett coming on for Alex Penfold. Our final substitution was in the 73rd minute when Corev Rose came on for Josh Uzun. It was only five minutes later that Jamie Byatt scored his third goal to record his second hattrick for 'the Salts' with a sublime finish after a great build-up from the team. The rest of the game was played out with no further additions to the score.
