BERKS COUNTY History

Berks County FC is a community football club with over 35 youth teams and both Men's and Women's First Team designed to create an aspirational goal for our younger club players. The Club was founded from two clubs in 2009 by merging the junior teams of Sunninghill Saints and the Senior teams of Bracknell Rovers. The Men's first team initially played in the Thames Valley League. Lee Simpson and Ellis Woods joined the club with the aspiration to develop the Men's first team and in 2021 they were admitted into Combined Counties Division One.

In the 2022-23 season they reached the play-off's but were unable to progress. However, in 2023-24 season after some close play-off games they were promoted to the Combined Counties Premier Division North. Reaching Step 5 is a great achievement for the club and unlocks many new opportunities for them, such as playing in the FA Cup for the First Time.

The First Team have a ground share agreement with Ascot United and play at the Racecourse Ground. The junior section is primarily based around the Ascot/Sunningdale area with pitches across multiple locations.

With both the manager and coach suspended, the club was forced into a number of changes. To make matters worse, skipper Adam Green was feeling unwell and unable to play.

The Salts got off to the worst possible start, with a defensive slip allowing Nathan Hogan to fire under poalkeeper Daniel O'Donovan, making it 1-0 to the Lobsters. Just a minute later, former Salt Adam Grant scored to double Redhill's lead.

In the 22nd minute, a great run by Kionte set up Jason Bloor, who drilled a low shot past the keeper to bring the Salts back into the game at 2–1. The momentum shifted, and in the 32nd minute, a superb 18ard strike from Will Kendal brought the Salts level at 2–2. By half time, the game was evenly poised, with Epsom & Ewell playing the better football as the first half drew to a close.

At half-time, the Salts were forced into a substitution as Conrad Essilfie-Conduan went off injured and was replaced by Craig Dundas. However, the second half started poorly for the Salts, as Redhill restored their lead just three minutes after the restart, making it 3-2 in the 48th minute.

The game's turning point came in the 77th minute when the referee, who had a very poor performance throughout, awarded a controversial penalty to Redhill. To compound matters, goalkeeper Daniel O'Donovan was booked and subsequently sent off. Skipper Ethan Nelson-Roberts attempted to speak to the referee but was sin-binned, leaving the Salts down to nine men.

With no choice, Kailan North stepped in as goalkeeper, but Redhill converted the penalty to make it 4-2 against the nine-man Salts. The referee's inconsistency was glaring, as Redhill players avoided bookings. while numerous Salts players were penalised.

Despite the challenges, Epsom & Ewell continued to push for another goal. Sean Michael Anderson replaced Luke Miller in the 66th minute, followed by Callum Wilson coming on for Niall Stillwell in the 83rd minute. The final substitution saw Jack Torbett replace Gillfillian Wual.

The Salts fought bravely but could not add to their tally.

It was a gruelling day on the island for the Salts with only two subs. In came young on loan goalkeeper Kevin Kardel who produced some quality saves especially in the first half.



The Club reserves the right to amend, alter or update this Code of Conduct and to eject, ban or prosecute as appropriate/necessary at their sole discretion.

Please remember that your behaviour reflects on Epsom & Ewell FC and could result in fines and in extreme cases heavier sanctions being imposed upon the club.

Entering and Leaving the ground

Please don't enter if you have Covid or Covid like symptoms or have been in close contact with anyone who has Covid. If you have driven to the ground, please park your vehicle considerately, don't block in others, and in particular don't block our neighbours' access to their houses. Out of respect for our neighbours, please keep noise levels down, especially late-night revelry, and don't litter the area. Don't attempt to bring Flares or Fireworks of any description into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and suspicious objects, and any found will be confiscated. No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and suspicious objects, and any found will be confiscated. Don't attempt to bypass the gate security checks, smuggle drinks of any kind into the ground or bypass the turnstiles without payment. Anyone found doing so will be evicted from the ground.

Within the ground

Be respectful to club officers, staff, security, stewards, and other fans at all times. Don't obstruct the normal activities of the Club and its officers. Don't stand in seating areas or access gangways or steps. Don't behave in a manner that compromises the comfort, enjoyment or safety of others. Always behave appropriately and don't bring the Club into disrepute. The following behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction and ban. Being drunk or under the influence of drugs and behaving anti socially. Threatening behaviour, use of obscene or abusive language, persistent swearing and/or making vulgar gestures.
