Founded in 1922 as the London & District Combination Football League, and renamed the Combined Counties Football League in 1978, the 2024–25 Cherry Red Combined CCL season will be the 47th in the history of the league. The league consists of four divisions for the second time, with a new Division Two being added to the Premier North, the Premier South and Division One. Division Two is intended largely for reserve and U23 sides, although it is also open to first teams.








Premier Division North










Welcome to Tadley Calleva





Tadley has had a football team since the early 1900's. In the modern era the team was re-formed in 1989 and played in the Basingstoke and North Hants Leagues before winning promotion to the Hampshire League. The club was formed as Tadley F.C. in 1989. They joined the Hampshire League Division Three in 1994, finishing runners-up in 1995–96, gaining promotion to Division Two. The club changed its name to Tadley Town F.C. in 1999 and joined Division One upon re-organisation. In 2004, they changed their name to their present name and entered the Wessex Football League Division Three.

Division Three was re-named Division Two in 2006, and the club finished runners-up in 2007. In the 2007–08 season, they won the Wessex League Division One title but were denied promotion as their ground did not meet the requirements for the Premier Division. The Reserve side was also highly successful in the same season by taking the Wessex Combination League title.

Since then the team has remained in Division One and has steadily been making progress on and off the field year on year. They narrowly missed out on promotion in 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively by finishing in 3rd position in both seasons.

In the 2010–11 campaign they reached the final of the Basingstoke Senior Cup losing to Thatcham Town 4–1. The club then went on to win the same cup in 2013-14 beating local rivals AFC Aldermaston 3-2 (aet) in the final. In September 2014, the club recorded probably the best result of its modern history, defeating Conference South Basingstoke Town on penalties in the Hampshire FA Senior Cup at The Camrose after a 2-2 draw in 90 minutes.

The club had its best run in the FA Vase in season 2015-16 reaching the 3rd round proper before eventually being knocked out 4-2 after a replay and extra-time against Newport (IoW) from the Wessex Premier Division.

They have also reached the final of the North Hants Senior Cup in the last two seasons; losing out 3-1 to local rivals Whitchurch United in 2016-17, again at The Camrose, and then 5-4 on penalties to Andover New Street in 2017-18 at Longmeadow after a 3-3 draw in normal time.

Welcome to Tadley Calleva



The club achieved its ambition of gaining promotion to the Wessex League Premier Division in 2018-19 season - the highest level (Step 5) that the club has competed at. The goal is to consolidate its position on the field and to make significant progress with the infrastructure off the field. Tadley finished 8th in their first season.

Tadley were lying 13th after 28 games in season in 2019-20. The season finished in March due to Coronavirus.

In 2020-21 Tadley had a change in Secretary, after many years Dean Newton step down. The club would like to place on record are thanks for the work and time put in by Dean. Wayne Chivers stepped as temporary secretary. After no one come forward, Wayne Chivers took it up on a full time basis.

In 2020/21 Tadley had their best run in the FA cup in the club's history, team manager Adam Clarke saw the club reach the First qualifying round.

In 2021/22 Tadley Calleva has seen a chance in league and management, the club has joined the Combined Counties League. This was due to the FA restructuring at Steps 4-6. Adam Clarke had to step down due to work commitments, we wished Adam the best of luck. Joe Lawler & Ben Dillon was named as joint first team managers 2021/22 season. We have enjoyed a good run under the joint managers for the past 2 and half seasons.



We made a few changes from Saturday's league win over Lineup Alton, with Craig Dundas returning up front. This was a tough match against a team from a higher division, as South Park play at Step 4.

We started strongly, but the home side took the lead in the 28th minute when a ball across the goal was met at the far post by James McElligott. We responded quickly and equalised in the 32nd minute with a stunning low, swerving drive from over 25 yards by skipper Adam Green, which flew into the bottom left-hand corner to make it 1-1.

Just before half-time, Craig McGee restored South Park's lead. However, we bounced back again, and a clumsy challenge on Ali Fofahan resulted in a penalty. Skipper Adam Green stepped up and calmly slotted home with the last kick of the half, making it 2-2 at the break.

The Salts took the lead in the 63rd minute after Kionte Gillfillian-Waul intercepted a pass across the back line. The ball fell to Craig Dundas, who smartly left it, allowing Gillfillian-Waul to run through and fire home his first goal for the club with a low drive from 15 yards.

Keeper Sami Nabbad then made a great low save, but the ball was sent straight back across goal, where Craig McGee was on hand to score his second and South Park's third from close range in the 80th minute, making it 3-3. Shortly after, Anthony Nazareth picked up a yellow card.

With the game seemingly heading for extra time, Sean-Michael Anderson broke free in the 90th minute and fired home from close range to make it 4-3 to the Salts. The players, management, committee, and supporters erupted in celebration.

Amid the celebrations, we picked up a few bookings, with Craig Dundas, Ali Fofahan, and Kionte Gillifillian-Waul all shown yellow cards. However, the Salts held firm to secure a dramatic 4-3 victory against higher-league opposition.

Ground Regulations 2024-25

The Club reserves the right to amend, alter or update this Code of Conduct and to eject, ban or prosecute as appropriate/necessary at their sole discretion.

Please remember that your behaviour reflects on Epsom & Ewell FC and could result in fines and in extreme cases heavier sanctions being imposed upon the club.

Entering and Leaving the ground

Please don't enter if you have Covid or Covid like symptoms or have been in close contact with anyone who has Covid. If you have driven to the ground, please park your vehicle considerately, don't block in others, and in particular don't block our neighbours' access to their houses. Out of respect for our neighbours, please keep noise levels down, especially late-night revelry, and don't litter the area. Don't attempt to bring Flares or Fireworks of any description into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and suspicious objects, and any found will be confiscated. No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and suspicious objects, and any found will be confiscated. Don't attempt to bypass the gate security checks, smuggle drinks of any kind into the ground or bypass the turnstiles without payment. Anyone found doing so will be evicted from the ground.

Within the ground

Be respectful to club officers, staff, security, stewards, and other fans at all times. Don't obstruct the normal activities of the Club and its officers. Don't stand in seating areas or access gangways or steps. Don't behave in a manner that compromises the comfort, enjoyment or safety of others. Always behave appropriately and don't bring the Club into disrepute. The following behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction and ban. Being drunk or under the influence of drugs and behaving anti socially. Threatening behaviour, use of obscene or abusive language, persistent swearing and/or making vulgar gestures. Racial, homophobic or any other form of discriminatory abuse, chanting or harassment. Fighting. Entering the field of play before, during or after the game. The throwing of any missile or object onto the field of play. The letting off of any flare or firework.

Furthermore, **the following are strictly forbidden** and may result in immediate eviction and ban for repeat offenders...

The climbing up or onto floodlights, stands, buildings, roofs, fences or any other structure. The obstruction of any walkways and pedestrian routes. The playing of ball games in areas populated by ground visitors. Allowing any animal to roam off the leash within the ground confines. The parking of any vehicle blocking Emergency Vehicle access. The length of any ban imposed will be related to the severity of offence and solely at the discretion of The Club.
