It's easy to focus on the outcome, but we felt once again that the performance and effort were there. On another day, if we had taken one or two of the ten really good chances we created, it would have been a very different and more positive result for us. 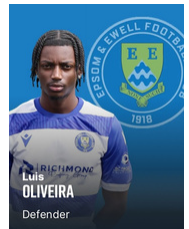

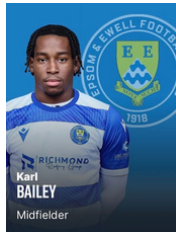

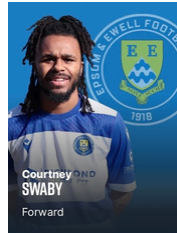

# Welcome to Alton



The present Alton FC was formed in July 2016 with the merger of Alton Town and Alton United Youth Football Club. This came about following years of negotiations with the brewery regarding the Bass Ground. Alton Town returned to their spiritual home at the Anstey Park Enclosure in December 2015. The merger with Alton United Youth Football Club formed one club for the start of season 2016-17, with teams encompassing all soccer from minis up to FA Step five standard with girls, men's, ladies, Veterans and Walking Football teams.

Alton Town was formed in 1990 when Alton's two senior clubs, Alton Town and Bass Alton, amalgamated. Alton Town had been fantastically successful, winning everything in Hampshire in the period from 1948 to 1956 including Hampshire leagues Divisions 3, 2 & 1 (1948, 1949 & 1958), the Hampshire Intermediate Cup in 1949, the Russell Cotes Cup in 1949 and the Hampshire Senior Cup in 1958.

Alton Town first joined the Hampshire League in 1947 and won Division 3 East in their first season. More success followed with the Division 2 title in 1948/49 and they also won the Russell Cotes Cup and Hampshire Intermediate Cup that year. Although they dropped to Division 2 for one season in 1954/55, they bounced back immediately and went on to win both the Division 1 championship and the Hampshire Senior Cup in 1957/58. They stayed in Division 1 until they left in 1973 to join the Athenian League Division 2 which they won in their first year. After an initial period of success in that league the Club found itself unable to compete and dropped down to the Combined Counties League before returning to the Hampshire League in 1984, starting at the bottom in Division 3. They found themselves in Division 2 in 1986/87 by dint of winning the Division 2 title for the third time.

Bass Alton started life as Courage & Company (Alton) FC and joined the Hampshire League in 1928/29. The following year they were in Division 2 and then won promotion to Division 1 where they stayed until being relegated to Division 2 in 1938/39, just before the club was disbanded for the War.

Courage rejoined the North Hants division briefly in 1954/55 before beginning their longest spell in the County League in 1972/73 when they entered Division 4. Promoted to Division 3 in 1975, they only lasted two years before dropping to Division 4 again. In 1979/80 the Club changed its name to Bass Alton FC and its fortunes changed with the name as they won promotion in successive years to Division 3 in 1979/80, to Division 2 in 1980/81 and to Division 1 as Division 2 runners-up and the end of the 1982/83 season after a 45-year absence. Since the amalgamation, the Club played in the Hampshire League and achieved promotion to the Wessex League by topping the Premier Division in 2002, while not setting the world alight, we were moved to the Premier Division of the Cherry Red Records Combined Counties League from season 2013-14.

# Welcome to Alton



Season 2015-16 saw Alton Town moved back in the Sydenhams League (Wessex) after the FA re-organisation of step six. After a few years of indifferent performances, we went for a more local management team as we looked to encouraged the flow of players from the Youth set up through to the First Team.

Following the FA Restructure of the pyramid and two successful, albeit aborted seasons we have were promoted to step five and the Wessex Premier Division for season 2021-22. A middle table finish was followed by more lateral movement as the FA moved us back to the Combined Counties League Premier Division South, for season 2022-23 and this is where we remain today.

The last few seasons have allowed us to consolidate after a number of years and with continued support from main sponsors Coomers and Exclusive Networks the long-term future for the club after years of uncertainty looks bright.

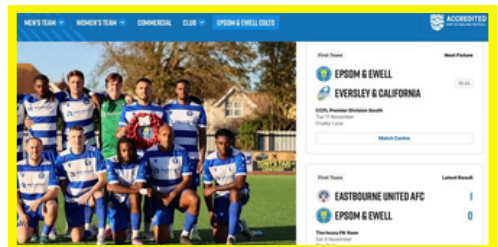

# Mutton's Musings



These 'Musings' are being written after all four games were completed on Bank Holiday Monday. All of these results had ramifications for both the top and bottom of the table, which I will cover below.

On Monday morning, the biggest losers were Redhill, who suffered a heavy home defeat to Knaphill (I will not mention the score), effectively ending their play-off hopes. It will also provide a boost to Eversley & California, who face Redhill in their final match next Saturday; a win would take them to 36 points and give them a real chance of survival.

Fleet Town drew 2-2 at home to champions Cobham, scoring both goals in the final eight minutes. That result secures fourth place for Fleet, thanks to their superior goal difference over Horley Town, who finish fifth. Fleet will now face Tooting & Mitcham in the semi-finals at Imperial Fields, where a four-figure crowd could well be on the cards. Horley Town, meanwhile, travel to Tadley Calleva in the other semi-final. Camberley, following their defeat at Tadley, remain in the relegation zone. Second place, held by Tadley Calleva, is particularly valuable as it guarantees home advantage in both the semi-final and, potentially, the final — although they must first overcome Horley.

The semi-final play-offs (dates to be confirmed) are as follows:

Tadley Calleva (2nd) v Horley Town (5<sup>th</sup>) and Tooting & Mitcham (3rd) v Fleet Town (4th)

It is somewhat unusual that six teams have already completed their season. The disparity in fixtures is largely due to the wet weather in January and February, which caused numerous postponements.

As predicted, Knaphill and Abbey Rangers have now fallen away from the play-off race. Knaphill's three-point deduction for fielding an ineligible player has proved costly, while Abbey's recent defeats to Tadley and Fleet ended their challenge.

At the bottom, Camberley Town recorded a late win over a struggling Corinthian Casuals side. Meanwhile, Eversley & California grabbed a dramatic injury-time equaliser at Redhill — reportedly only their second shot on target, coming in the 93rd minute. It highlights how unpredictable results can be at this stage of the season. The battle to avoid the final relegation spot remains between ourselves, Camberley and Eversley & California. Eversley host Redhill next Saturday, while Camberley face Alton — both difficult to call. Camberley could stay up with a draw if Eversley lose, due to their superior goal difference. That said, our destiny remains firmly in our own hands. A point from our remaining fixtures will be enough to secure our status.

**Epsom & Ewell were forced into a late reshuffle ahead of kick-off after Ali Fofahan was delayed in traffic, and the disruption appeared to have an early impact on the side. Karl Bailey came into the starting XI in place of the delayed Fofahan, replacing Craig Dundas in the starting eleven, while Prince Aderogba joined the back five to cover for the injured Antonios Nazareth. Otherwise, the team remained largely settled following the important win at Guildford City.**

The first half offered little in terms of quality or rhythm, with both sides struggling to establish control. The game became fragmented, with long balls and second balls dominating proceedings as both teams battled for territory rather than building sustained passages of play. Despite the lack of fluency, Epsom & Ewell did create an early opportunity when Jason Vincent found himself clean through, but his effort was well saved by the Sutton Common Rovers goalkeeper.

As the half wore on, clear chances remained at a premium, and it always felt like a moment of error could prove decisive. That proved to be the case just before the interval, when a defensive mix-up at the back allowed Sutton Common Rovers to capitalise and take the lead, leaving the Salts trailing 1-0 at the break.

The second half followed a similar pattern, although Epsom & Ewell showed greater urgency in their play and looked to apply more pressure on the visitors. They began to create more promising situations in attacking areas, but the final touch continued to evade them. Callum O'Keeffe had a good opportunity from just inside the area but was unable to make clean contact, while Kionte Gillfillian-Waul was a constant outlet down the left flank, repeatedly getting into dangerous positions and delivering balls into the box.

However, Sutton Common Rovers defended their lead resolutely, often with numbers behind the ball, blocking efforts and forcing the Salts into rushed or desperate attempts. Despite enjoying spells of possession and territory, Epsom & Ewell were unable to find the breakthrough. In the end, it was another frustrating home defeat for the Salts, who will feel they had enough of the ball but lacked the cutting edge required to take something from the game.

# Ground Regulations 2025-26



## **Spectator Code of Conduct**

All spectators attending home matches are required to read and comply with this Code of Conduct, and to respect the same principles when attending our away fixtures at other clubs. Entry to the Ground shall constitute acceptance of this Code of Conduct, the rules and regulations of The Football Association and The Combined Counties League. The Club reserves the right to amend, alter or update this Code of Conduct and to eject, ban or prosecute as appropriate or necessary at their sole discretion. Please remember that your behaviour reflects on Epsom & Ewell FC and could result in fines and, in extreme cases, heavier sanctions being imposed upon the club.

## **Entering and Leaving the Ground**

If you have driven to the ground, please park your vehicle considerately. Out of respect for our neighbours, please keep noise levels down, especially late at night, and do not litter the area. Do not attempt to bring flares, fireworks or any other dangerous items into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and confiscate any prohibited items found. No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought into the ground. Do not attempt to bypass the gate security checks, smuggle drinks of any kind into the ground, or bypass the turnstiles without payment. Anyone found doing so will be evicted from the ground.

## **Within the Ground**

Be respectful to club officers, staff, security, stewards, and other fans at all times. Do not obstruct the normal activities of the Club and its officers. Do not stand in seating areas or block access gangways or steps. Do not behave in a manner that compromises the comfort, enjoyment or safety of others. Always behave appropriately and do not bring the Club into disrepute.

The following behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction and ban: being drunk or under the influence of drugs and behaving antisocially; threatening behaviour; use of obscene or abusive language; persistent swearing and/or making vulgar gestures; racial, homophobic or any other form of discriminatory abuse, chanting or harassment; fighting; entering the field of play before, during or after the game; throwing any missile or object onto the field of play; and setting off any flare or firework.

## **Strictly Forbidden**

The following are strictly forbidden and may result in immediate eviction and a ban for repeat offenders: the consumption of alcohol in bottles, cans or glasses in the stands, terraces and other open areas within the ground; climbing onto floodlights, stands, buildings, roofs, fences or any other structure; obstruction of any walkways and pedestrian routes; playing ball games in areas populated by ground visitors; only service animals are permitted at Chalky Lane and must be kept on a leash.

Vehicles must ensure they do not block emergency vehicle access.

The length of any ban imposed will be related to the severity of the offence and solely at the discretion of the Club. Any appeal may be made in writing through the Club Secretary and will be given full and due consideration.
