Balham Football Club was formed in 2011 in order to provide player progression into open age football for the hugely talented, high achieving age group teams of

Balham Blazers FC, which was founded by Greg Cruttwell in 2001.

Having won back-to-back promotions in 2011/12 and 2012/13 Balham did the league and cup double in the Surrey South Eastern Combination in 2013/14

In 2014/15 Balham finished in a promotion position again, in the Surrey Elite Intermediate Football League, however promotion was denied due to Combined Counties League facility requirements not being met.

Having moved to ground share with Cobham FC, in order to meet the facility requirements, Balham finished as runners up in the SEIFL in 2015/16 and as a result were promoted to Division One of the Combined Counties League for the 2016/17 season.

The club had an exceptional first league campaign at Step 6, finishing in a promotion position for the sixth consecutive season and winning the London Senior Trophy.

In 2017/18 the club had an equally exceptional season, finishing 5th at Step 5 in the Premier Division of the CCL and winning the London

Senior Cup.

2021/22 will be the club's fifth season at this level after flirting with relegation in 2018/19 and then having null and void seasons in 2019/20 and 2020/21 due to COVID-19.

Having begun on Wimbledon Extension, before moving to Cobham and then to the Wibbandune Stadium, where the club ground shared with Colliers Wood Utd, Balham were on the move again in 2020, this time to the Mayfield Stadium, where the club has embarked on a two-year ground share agreement with AFC Croydon Athletic. Moving location meant having to move sideways in the Football League Pyramid, from the Premier Division of the CCL into the Premier Division of the SCEFL (South East Counties Football League)

After one single season in the SCEFL however, which was curtailed due to COVID-19, the FA brought Balham back to the Combined Counties League for the 2021/22 season, at the same level, in a newly formed Premier League South.

The 21/22 season we were back in the Combined Counties League Premier South – and great to play against some of the teams we have faced many times before as well as some new ones. Despite it being our second highest finish in the division, we couldn't find consistency, there was a notable effort in the Surrey FA Senior Cup where

Balham 1- 3 Bedfont Sports (Southern Combination Cup Second Round)

Balham FC conjures admirable start against Bedfont Sports but tap out as experience proves the vital edge in Combination scrap.

A token for both teams to keep players fit and hopefully mend their shared run of form.

Balham, eager to prove themselves, would set the bar as they invited Bedfont in to battle for possession in the air. Back and forth like tennis, both sides were looking for an early break, however neither would manifest anything convincing.

As play opened Balham remained boisterous and persisted in their aggressive press, finally rewarded when James Anderson (10) left the opposition's keeper dazed as he lasered one in from long range.

Celebrations were cut short due to an evident hunger for one more, an unfortunate mistake as an inattentive clearance would leave Bedfont's George Frise (8) free to slot one bottom left moments before the whistle.

Unable to see out the first half Balham had gifted the opposition a fresh start and clearly provoked a furious response from Bedfont's manager. Far quicker to get on the front foot, something had stuck. They were now playing their football primarily on the ground effectively stretching the pitch.

Balham exhausting their energy upfront, would leave the backline vulnerable to several searching counter balls. Once in the box a couple of smart passes resulted in a demeaning tap-in for Bedfont's James Barnell (9).

Now an even bigger emphasis on getting bodies up the pitch Balham would be victim to yet another counterattack, 11 minutes later, Tommy Oneill (2) set out on an impressive dribble slotting it away for Bedfont's third. The defending efforts being a massive contrast to the level of bravery present in the previous half.

Balham FC battle it out

snatching an early Christmas present but will need to work harder if they're to evade Santa's naughty list. Both sides find themselves separated by just four points as they face off for the first time this season. Balham, set on recreating their last admirable 3-1 win over Chipstead, wasted no time in launching the ball up-field to utilise Rylan Wither's blistering pace. Yet it would be equal pressure on both backlines, Chipstead's the first to give out, narrowly escaping punishment. Similarly, Balham would be

saved by the linesman, as

Chipstead retaliated with an offside goal. On the verge of conceding Balham now appeared a fraction more energetic as they continued to soak up the pressure to hopefully break away on the counter.

A mightily even first half, each team as close as the other to going ahead with the amusing number of corners providing the most convincing chances.

Once again Balham would be first to open the half hitting the post from long range and just a minute later slicing it wayward one-on-one with the keeper. Tempers were swaying from unruffled to ruffled as both teams clashed heads far harder than the previous half.

Twelve minutes in the first blow would be delivered, a devastating through ball leaving Chipstead's Carl Oblitey (9) open to drive it bottom right. Forced to rebuild their momentum, Balham spent solid minutes in the opponents' final third heavily favouring the right wing. Any loss in possession they were swift to read play and pinch it back, an equaliser looked inbound. All throw-ins were long, all flick-ons were aggressive, but the ball showed no mercy in dropping for one of the Balham boys. Finally, a string of elegant passes would put them through but to their disbelief a controversial offside call would prevent them from levelling.

Any hope for a point dispersed rapidly when Oblitey bagged again. Unable to clear their

lines Balham allowed an easy finish at close range. A cold slap in the face for Balham and a scoreline certainly not reflective of the grit and persistence on show. Props must be given to the opposition's keeper, successful in cutting off multiple one-on-ones, he singlehandedly kept Balham at bay. Balham aware that this game could've prevailed very differently will aim to be far more clinical this Saturday (20th) as they host Epsom & Ewell. An increase of shots at goal may spark a much-needed prolific run of goals.
