From the Bench



We welcome everyone to Chalky Lane for the visit of Bedfont Sports in the cup. After a long time away from Chalky Lane, it's great to be back for three games in six days, and to see so many of you coming to watch — especially on Saturday when we were fortunate to have children from our U9s and BMM Sports Coaching in attendance. It was fantastic to see so many faces cheering us on.



Last Saturday we welcomed Camberley to Chessington in what was a vital six-pointer. The first half was one where we dominated in terms of chances and really should have been one or two goals ahead, which has been a recurring theme this season. Camberley were reduced to 10 men on 30 minutes and, as we've seen before, we found it difficult to break down a low block. We had plenty of possession and huffed and puffed, but without creating any real clear-cut chances. A point was a step in the right direction, but it was frustrating not to take all three.

Onto Tuesday, where we faced play-off chasing Redhill — another game where missed chances proved costly. We started well, restricting Redhill while looking composed in possession ourselves. Going into half-time, we knew we needed to find a goal. That became even clearer five minutes into the second half when we conceded a poor goal, switching off after a shot hit the post and allowing the rebound to be converted. What was pleasing, though, was the reaction from the boys, and we were rewarded when Tom Collins capitalised on a goalkeeping error to make it 1–1.

From there, the game became a midfield battle before we entered injury time — a problematic period for us this season. We have now dropped 21 points from last-minute goals, which is a difficult statistic to accept, and once again we switched off and conceded from a defensive point of view. What could have been a valuable point wasn't to be, and we know the league and survival remain our priority. However, the cup provides a welcome distraction, and one we are keen to defend. We have a strong record in cup competitions and see this as an opportunity to bring more silverware to the club.

In terms of the squad, you will have seen Jason Vincent and Courtney Swaby join the club, both of whom have made a real impression. This is the first time this season that we have had something close to a full group available — excluding trips to Bermuda!

We would like to welcome Alfie, his staff, board and supporters to Chalky Lane tonight, and thank them for their support throughout the season, particularly with dual registrations. Bedfont Sports have had a very positive season and will provide a tough test for us today.

Welcome to Bedfont Sports



Bedfont Sports Football Club is a modern and ambitious non-league club based in Bedfont, within the London Borough of Hounslow. Founded in 2002, the club has made steady and notable progress through the English football pyramid in a relatively short period of time.

Formation and Early Development

The club was established to provide a structured football pathway within the local community and initially competed in the Hounslow & District League. Early success on the pitch saw Bedfont Sports progress quickly, earning promotion into the Middlesex County Football League.

In the 2004–05 season, the club achieved promotion to the Middlesex County League Premier Division, marking a significant early milestone in its development. This progression was supported by continued improvements both on and off the field, including enhancements to facilities at their home ground on Hatton Road.

Rise Through the Middlesex County League

Bedfont Sports continued to build their reputation in the Middlesex County League Premier Division over the following seasons. Their performances at this level established them as a competitive and well-organised club, capable of challenging for further advancement.

This progress culminated in the 2008–09 season, when the club achieved promotion to the Combined Counties League, taking a further step up within the National League System.

Combined Counties League Progress

Bedfont Sports joined the Combined Counties League Division One for the 2009–10 season. After settling into the division, the club produced a strong campaign in 2011–12, finishing as runners-up, which secured promotion to the Combined Counties League Premier Division.

Competing at Step 5, Bedfont Sports established themselves as a consistent presence in the Premier Division. The club's most successful period at this level came in the 2017–18 season, when they finished as runners-up in the Combined Counties League Premier Division. This achievement earned them promotion to the Isthmian League, marking their first step into Step 4 football.

Isthmian League and Return to Step 5

Following promotion, Bedfont Sports competed in the Isthmian League South Central Division during the 2018–19 season. This represented the highest level the club had reached since its formation.

However, the club returned to Step 5 in subsequent seasons, rejoining the Combined Counties League. During this period, Bedfont Sports remained competitive and continued to develop both their playing squad and infrastructure.

Recent Success and Promotion

In the 2024–25 season, Bedfont Sports achieved another major milestone by securing promotion back to Step 4 via the Combined Counties League Premier Division South play-offs. This success saw the club return to the Isthmian League South Central Division for the 2025–26 season.

This promotion underlined the club's continued ambition and ability to compete at the higher levels of non-league football.

Ground and Facilities

Bedfont Sports play their home matches at the Bedfont Recreation Ground, often referred to as Hatton Road. Over time, the club has made steady improvements to the ground to meet the requirements of higher-level football, including upgrades to playing surfaces and spectator facilities.

The development of the ground has been an important factor in the club's rise through the leagues, enabling them to meet ground grading criteria at each step of progression.

Community and Identity

Despite being a relatively young club, Bedfont Sports has built strong links within the local community. The club runs youth and development teams, providing opportunities for players to progress into senior football.

This emphasis on community engagement has been central to the club's identity and long-term sustainability.

Today

Now competing once again in the Isthmian League South Central Division, Bedfont Sports continue to build on over two decades of progress. From their beginnings in local league football to competing at Step 4, the club's journey reflects steady growth, strong organisation and clear ambition.

While still young compared to many non-league clubs, Bedfont Sports have established themselves as a respected and upwardly mobile club within the English football pyramid.

Player to Watch - Joe Smith

Joe Smith is a defender for Bedfont Sports and has been one of the club's most regularly used players during the 2025–26 Isthmian League South Central Division season.


At the time of the latest published appearance records, Smith had made 35 appearances, placing him among Bedfont Sports' most frequently selected players in the current campaign and scoring two goals. That level of involvement underlines his importance within the side since their return to Step 4 football.

One of Smith's most notable contributions came in Bedfont Sports' 3–2 opening-day win over Kingstonian. In stoppage time, Lewis Flatman delivered a free-kick to the back post, where Smith headed the ball down for Ollie Davison to score the winner. It was a decisive moment in a victory that gave Bedfont a winning return to Step 4.

Official line-up information also shows Smith being used in defensive positions. In earlier Bedfont team sheets he was listed at left-back, and his current club profile continues to identify him simply as a defender.

What can be said with certainty is that Smith has been a regular presence in Bedfont's side and has already made a tangible contribution in a key result this season. His stoppage-time assist against Kingstonian stands out in the club's published match reporting, and his appearance numbers point to a player trusted by the management across the campaign.

For opposition sides, that makes Joe Smith a player to watch: a defender with consistent selection behind him and a proven contribution in an important match this season.



I believe we all know that Tadley Calleva have already secured one of those; the current very impressive unbeaten run they are on surely will see them secure a place in the next couple of matches. In third place are the Jekyll and Hyde team of the division, Tooting and Mitcham who can easily get beaten well one week and then bounce back the next.

Spectator Code of Conduct

Please remember that your behaviour reflects on Epsom & Ewell FC and could result in fines and, in extreme cases, heavier sanctions being imposed upon the club.

Entering and Leaving the Ground

If you have driven to the ground, please park your vehicle considerately. Out of respect for our neighbours, please keep noise levels down, especially late at night, and do not litter the area. Do not attempt to bring flares, fireworks or any other dangerous items into the ground. We reserve the right to check all bags and confiscate any prohibited items found. No alcoholic drinks are allowed to be brought into the ground. Do not attempt to bypass the gate security checks, smuggle drinks of any kind into the ground, or bypass the turnstiles without payment. Anyone found doing so will be evicted from the ground.

Within the Ground

Be respectful to club officers, staff, security, stewards, and other fans at all times. Do not obstruct the normal activities of the Club and its officers. Do not stand in seating areas or block access gangways or steps. Do not behave in a manner that compromises the comfort, enjoyment or safety of others. Always behave appropriately and do not bring the Club into disrepute.

The following behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in immediate eviction and ban: being drunk or under the influence of drugs and behaving antisocially; threatening behaviour; use of obscene or abusive language; persistent swearing and/or making vulgar gestures; racial, homophobic or any other form of discriminatory abuse, chanting or harassment; fighting; entering the field of play before, during or after the game; throwing any missile or object onto the field of play; and setting off any flare or firework.

Strictly Forbidden

The following are strictly forbidden and may result in immediate eviction and a ban for repeat offenders: the consumption of alcohol in bottles, cans or glasses in the stands, terraces and other open areas within the ground; climbing onto floodlights, stands, buildings, roofs, fences or any other structure; obstruction of any walkways and pedestrian routes; playing ball games in areas populated by ground visitors; only service animals are permitted at Chalky Lane and must be kept on a leash.
